### **Costs for a 10' x10' site:**

CHECK 1: **\$25.00** (for a Hopewell Township Temporary Food License Application) payable to "Pennington Borough."

CHECK 2: Also payable to Pennington Borough as follows:

- **\$220** Full Menu for-profit vendor (eg. sausage, chips, sodas)
- **\$110** Full Menu non-profit vendor
- **\$110** Single item for profit vendor (eg. Funnel cakes only, icees only)
- **\$55** Single item non-profit vendor

## **Q & A:**

### ***Why do I need a Hopewell Township Temporary Food License in addition to the food vendor application?***

Every vendor or organization selling food must be licensed through the Hopewell Township Health Department. If you work out of a commercial kitchen and currently have a license please complete the form and indicate in the upper left-hand corner of the form: **waived**, or **license in place**.

**What if I am selling packaged goods?** Food licenses are not required for pre-packaged food, such as bagged chips or canned or bottled soda. Any food item which will be individually handled needs a license.

**What happens after I fill out the forms?** You will receive a confirmation letter. (Booth location to arrive later, closer to Pennington Day.)

### **Can I cook under a tent?**

No, local fire laws do not permit it.

### **Will there be electricity?**

No, unless you make an arrangement in advance with a local resident or business.

### **Can I bring a generator?**

Yes, the quieter the better!

### **Do I need a fire extinguisher?**

Yes, if you are cooking with a flame, an ABC Chemical Extinguisher is required.

### **What time do I need to be there?**

Set up begins at 6:30 a.m. and needs to be completed by 8:30 a.m. with all vehicles off the street. The fair opens at 10am.

### **What can I sell?**
